In the latest episode, a nationwide firm, Peiffer Wolf Carr Kane & Conway, announced that it was pursuing two fertility doctors who allegedly used their own sperm a generation ago to get women pregnant without informing them. This is just the tip of the iceberg according to Adam Wolf, the lawyer handling the cases. He claims that hundreds of fertility fraud cases will emerge across the US as people begin to investigate their genealogy using home DNA testing kits ... [Wolf] told the media: “The actions of these doctors are horrific. The gross misconduct committed by these doctors is a profoundly intimate betrayal ... We have to decide as a nation that the Wild West days for the IVF/fertility industry are over.”

Most abortions took place before 13 weeks gestation, but about 4,200 were committed in the second and third trimesters. 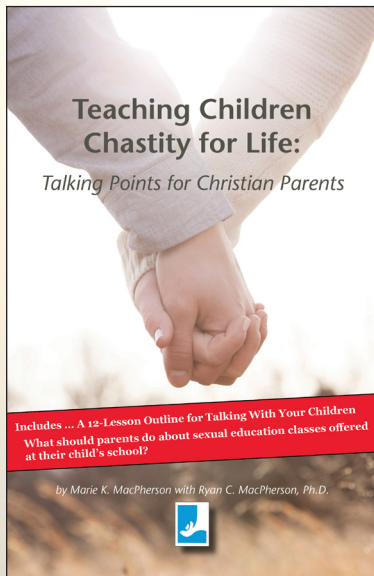

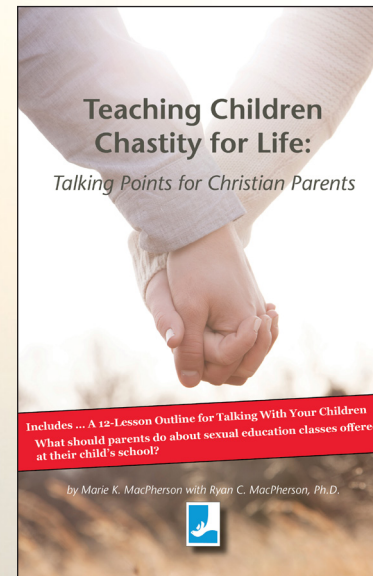
