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Welcomed Introduce yourself It's not enough that the signs or the mugs or the bulletins say "All are welcome" Each person is approached with a "we are so glad you are here" attitude

Known

* Ask questions

* What's your name?

* What or who brought you here today?

* What felt good/resonated with you?

* Remember the answers!

* Seek to find points of connection

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Accepted • We are all God's children • Unconditional positive regard for each person • Part of the Body of Christ • We've been waiting for YOU • Difference is created by Creator • You are just what we need

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Supported • Ask about visible support needs • How can we support your family? • How did we do? • Please describe your experience • Any barriers to participation? • What can we do for the next time you come?
