## Life Sunday Children's Message

Items needed: perhaps a small basket, bucket, or bowl of trinket toys or pieces of candy

Good morning, my brothers and sisters in Christ!

When I was your age, I liked to go to the dentist. Do you like to go to the dentist? I like feeling my teeth clean and smooth and strong. Sometimes I even got to watch a movie in the chair or choose what music to listen to!

But my favorite part of the dentist was the prize basket. They had a basket full of little toys right behind the front desk. At the end of my visit, if I had sat really still and I had been brushing well, I got to choose a prize. Not just a sticker or a sucker, but a toy! I loved to put my hand into the prize basket all the way to the bottom. And I'd shuffle it around looking for just the best one. I'd grab hold of this one and see what it was, then I'd pick up that one and look at it, and I'd set two or three that I really wanted off to the side.

Who do you think is God's favorite of all time? Our Almighty Maker, our Heavenly Father, who do you think He likes most? Some people say He likes angels the most. Some people say nice folks are His favorite. Some think it's the adults like me, but some think it's the younger ones like you.

Do we sometimes believe somebody else is God's favorite? When we see someone stronger than we are, do we feel like God loves them more? When we meet someone we find smarter than us, do we feel that God must love them most of all? Sometimes when our neighbor looks prettier or acts happier, or our classmate has more friends, or our brother or sister has better toys, we might tell ourselves God has chosen them to be more special.

Well, today Jesus has some good news for us. He's got really good news for you.

Our Savior and our Lord Jesus says, "Remember you did not choose me, but I chose you." God chose you! God chose you to be special when He knit you together in your mother's belly. "Remember you did not choose me, but I chose you."
