Despite false claims that pro-life pregnancy resource centers (PRCs) are “fake clinics,” PRCs have saved over 800,000 lives from the violence of abortion in just the past five recorded years (2016-2020). This information comes from a report entitled “Saved Impact at U.S. Pregnancy Help Centers,” published by the Charlotte Lozier Institute (CLI). ... According to CLI, the “lives saved measurement is specifically defined as the total number of pregnant women assessed as being at-risk for abortion who choose to carry and give birth to their child (or children, in the case of twins and multiples, whereby several lives are counted) after visiting a PHC.” The information is contained in a de-identified dataset, they noted. CLI defined abortion-minded (AM) versus abortion-vulnerable (AV) women as follows: An AV woman “has not eliminated the possibility of abortion; she lacks support from significant influencers; and she is undecided about her pregnancy.” An AM woman “is seeking information on how to obtain an abortion; she has an abortion scheduled; and an abortion procedure has been initiated (such as the introduction of laminaria, or ingestion of the first pill, Mifeprex, in chemical abortion).” In total, CLI says pregnancy centers have saved 828,131 lives in the U.S. (2016-2020).
