Blessed from the Beginning – Who Is My Neighbor? – Sometimes our neighbors are found in the most inconvenient places and times, and require from us more than we think we can give. Donna Harrison, M.D. dip ABOG, received BS and BA in Chemistry and Biochemistry from Michigan State University, MD and residency from University of Michigan, with additional studies in International Medicine at University of Arizona-Tucson. She served as associate clinical professor of obstetrics and gynecology at University of Michigan, then entered private practice with a multispecialty group involved in international medicine. While in private practice, she served on community health projects both locally and in Haiti and India. Dr. Harrison then retired from clinical practice to serve in Women’s Health Policy positions, most recently as President of the American Association of Pro-Life Obstetricians and Gynecologists. She has testified before the local, state, and federal governments, as well as the UN, and has lectured in medical schools, universities, and CME conferences, as well as published on the long-term effects after abortion, mifepristone, ulipristal, and maternal mortality and MDG 5.
