Lutherans For Life invites all Lutheran Churches to implement a **ONE-DAY CONGREGATIONAL EVENT** during LFL's Step Up 4 Life campaign. This celebratory event provides the perfect opportunity to uphold life AND support Lutherans For Life and its mission to equip Lutherans and their neighbors to be Gospel-motivated voices for Life. **HERE'S HOW TO MAKE IT HAPPEN:**

WHO:

Encourage your **ENTIRE CONGREGATION** to participate in a congregational 4 Life Day walk. Plan ahead and invite not only your congregation, but also community members, family, friends, neighbors, and visitors of all ages!

WHAT:

At your 4 Life Day event, **CREATE POSTERS** to show your support of LIFE from fertilization to forever. Posters can be created from purchased posterboard or items inside your Sunday school classrooms and held during your walk for life. WHEN:

We encourage all churches to hold their 4 Life Day walk and celebration between May 14 and June 24, during our Lutherans For Life Step Up 4 Life campaign. If possible, hold your 4Life Day walk on **JUNE 24**, the first anniversary of the overturning of Roe v Wade!

WHERE:

Pick the **TIME, DATE, ROUTE, AND LOCATION**, of your 4 Life Day walk. Choose to walk around a neighborhood, at a local park, on walking trails, at a community track, or around your capitol or courthouse.

WHY:

While participating in a one-day event that coincides with the Lutherans For Life Step Up 4 Life campaign, your 4 Life Day walk is an opportunity to **CELEBRATE** God's gift of Life, the overturning of Roe v. Wade, and the work of Lutherans For Life. Consider tying your walk to a meal and a free-will donation to **SUPPORT** the publication of Gospel-motivated educational materials and electronic resources at Lutherans For Life!
