THOSE WITH DISABILITIES ARE INDISPENSABLE ACTIVITIES

- ✓ Celebration
- ✓ Education
 - √ Service
 - ✓ Worship

Celebration

- ✓ Plan an outing for someone with a disability.
- Celebrate the birthday of those with disabilities.
- Spend time getting to know someone who has a disability.
- Send cards and gifts (quilts, fruit baskets, etc.) during holidays. Ask those with disabilities to participate.

Education

- ✓ Ask a speaker from LFL to speak on how to best serve those with disabilities in a life-affirming way.
- Ask an individual with a disability to speak about his/her disability.
- ✓ Host a panel discussion on a specific disability. Ask an individual with that disability to serve as an expert panel member.

Service

- Volunteer to tutor someone with a disability.
- ✓ Volunteer to aid a disabled classmate or church member.
- Offer to babysit for a family who has a child with disabilities.
- ✓ Volunteer at a nursing home; read stories to those with impaired vision.

Worship

- Ask those with a disability to suggest ways to make your church more disability friendly.
- ✓ Create large print bulletins.
- Request printed sermons for those who are hard of hearing.
- Participate in or start a Bible study for those with cognitive disabilties. Include a craft and social time.
