DID YOU KNOW?

An estimated 56.8 million people, including 25.7 million in the last year of life, are in need of palliative care.

Approximately 75% of women at risk for abortion who view an ultrasound of their baby at a pregnancy center ultimately make the choice to continue their pregnancy.

Common exceptions to abortion limits account for less than 5% of all abortions.

- Rape and incest: 0.4%
- Risk to the woman's life: 0.3%
- Other physical health concerns: 2.2%
- Abnormality in the unborn baby: 1.2%
- Elective and unspecified reasons: 95.9%

Certain factors tend to coincide with gender dysphoria: low self-esteem, anxiety, depression, lack of identity, eating disorders, personality disorder, self-injury, autism spectrum disorder, sexual trauma, gender trauma.

90% of Americans who die by suicide (the second leading cause of death among persons aged 10 to 34) have experienced symptoms of a treatable mental health condition such as depression, anxiety disorders, or other forms of serious mental illnesses.

An estimated 1.3 billion people experience significant disability. This represents 16% of the world's population, or one in six of us.

Ten states and the District of Columbia have legalized physicianassisted suicide (PAS) for patients said to have a terminal illness.

The heart is the embryo's first functioning organ, which starts to develop as early as 16 days after fertilization.

The term "gender" no longer means only male or female. Instead, gender now takes into account identity and expression. (According to healthline.com, there are 64 terms that describe gender.)

56% of Americans would feel uncomfortable telling their friends or family if they were suffering from a mental illness.

There are more than 2,700 pro-life pregnancy centers in all 50 states. Planned Parenthood has approximately 585 facilities in only 48 states.

2024 Highlights

- Highest number of monthly contacts (400+) in over a decade
- Providing spiritual care to the most individuals in a given month (14) and most within a year (31)
- Started eight-week mindfulness video class offered quarterly
- Partnered with Lutheran Family Services and trained three of their counseling staff on our abortion recovery program, Redeeming Grace
- Started Hope Day Wednesday, weekly 90 second Scripture reading and prayer on social media (FB and Instagram)

- Partner with Lutheran Family Services to hold Redeeming Grace Abortion Recovery Retreat

2024 Highlights

- Approximately 325 youth gathered at Y4Life in Washington, D.C., in January and learn about life issues, connect with other youth, and participate in the National March for Life!
- Over 70 youth attended the Y4Life Summit at Concordia Nebraska in February.
- Y4Life held its first Gender Conference and Apologetics Retreat in April!
- Our Y4Life Director spoke at several local, national, and continental youth events and conferences throughout 2024.
- Y4Life received four grants in 2024 whose proceeds will be used to expand its outreach in 2025.
- Y4Life established Lil' Lutherans 4 Life and created eight child-friendly prayer and encouragement brochures on morning prayer, night prayer, and six emotions.

- Reach over 1,000 youth through school visits and Engage and Equip events
- Expand our reach to include young adults in their 20s and 30s by hosting YA For Life retreats.
