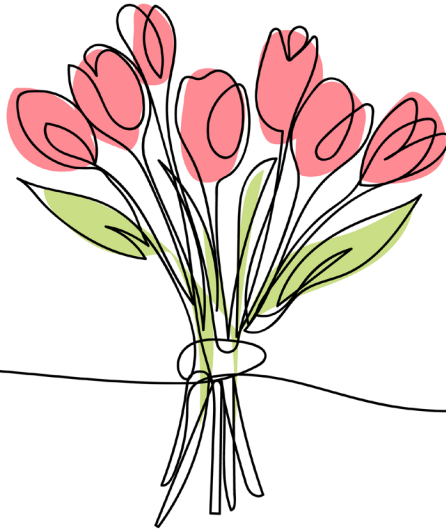

Moms make up a primary means by which the Almighty Himself wraps us in His compassion and happiness.

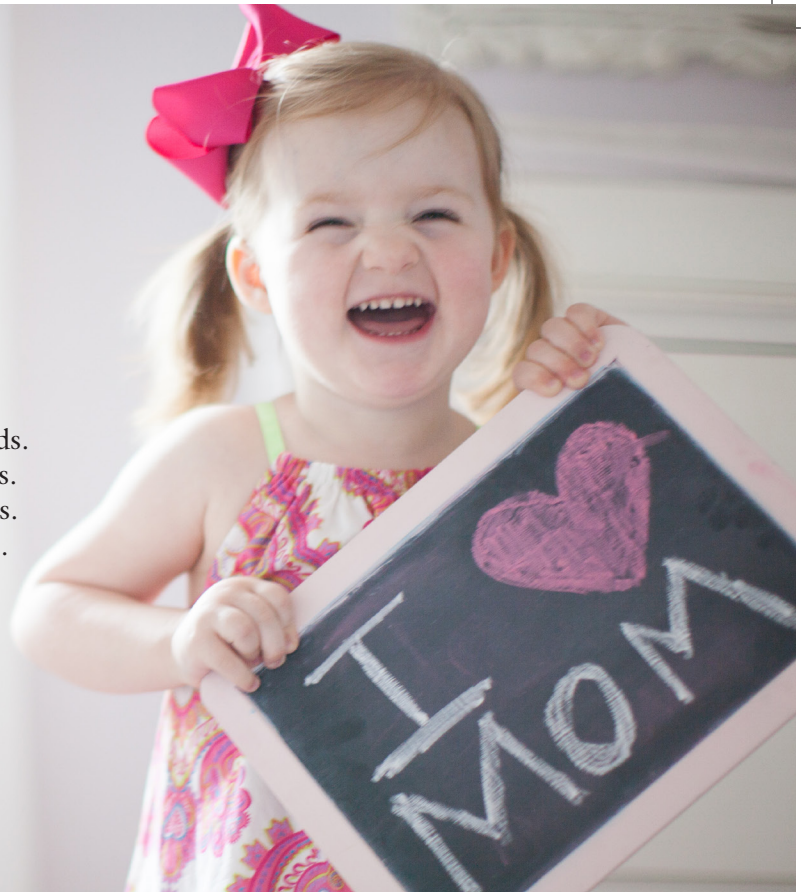
Our mamas don't come optional to any of us, and a father's care isn't equivalent to the love of a mother or interchangeable with it.
